On-Call Stream Restoration and Sanitary Sewer Repair

Action:

- A. Approve a unit price contract to the lowest responsive bidder Eagle Wood, Inc. for On-Call Stream Restoration and Sanitary Sewer Repair for one year, and**
- B. Authorize the City Manager to renew the contract for up to two, one-year terms with possible price adjustments and to amend the contract consistent with the purpose for which the contract was approved.**

Explanation

- This project includes repair of Charlotte Water infrastructure at multiple locations near streams. Stream stabilization structures shall be constructed to protect existing and proposed sanitary sewer infrastructure.
- Project components include natural in-stream structures, plantings, site grading, sanitary sewer replacement, sheet pile installation, bypass pumping and erosion, and sediment control measures.
- The following six project locations are identified in the contract documents and additional sites will be released during the contract duration.

Eastway and Irwin Creek (Council District 1)

Toby Creek (Council District 4)

McMullen and Creekridge (Council District 6)

Cherry Tree Lane (Council District 7)

- On July 20, 2018, the City issued an Invitation to Bid; two bids were received.
- Eagle Wood, Inc. was selected as the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.
- The renewals allow for possible price adjustments based on the Engineering News Record Construction Cost Index.
- Estimated annual expenditures are \$3,251,000.
