Traffic Signal LED Maintenance

Action:

Adopt a budget ordinance appropriating \$300,000 from the North Carolina Department of Transportation to the General Fund.

Explanation

- The City transitioned from incandescent to LED traffic signal displays more than 10 years ago. LED displays save energy and have a longer life than incandescent bulbs.
- The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) has a statewide traffic signal maintenance program.
- The City previously entered into a Municipal Agreement with NCDOT to maintain traffic control devices.
- NCDOT is providing \$300,000 to replace LED traffic signal displays at intersections of State roads the City maintains.
- This money will fund scheduled replacements at approximately one-third, or 165, of the 500 State intersections, as a part of a three year replacement schedule.
