

**RESOLUTION PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
CHARLOTTE, NORTH CAROLINA ON JUNE 8, 2026**

A motion was made by \_\_\_\_\_ and seconded by \_\_\_\_\_ for the adoption of the following Resolution and upon being put to a vote was duly adopted:

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has allocated Reconnecting Communities grant funding for planning of the Rozzelles Ferry Mobility Path (the "Project"), and

WHEREAS, A Grant Agreement between the City and the FHWA will provide up to \$1,290,480 in federal funding to the Project with a local match in the amount of \$322,250 from the Corridors of Opportunity, and

WHEREAS, the Grant Agreement specifies that planning costs are eligible for funds, and

WHEREAS, the format and cost-sharing philosophy is consistent with past Grant Agreements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a Grant Agreement with the FHWA for the City to receive \$1,290,480 for transportation improvements to the Project is hereby formally adopted by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, and the City Manager and Clerk of this Municipality are hereby empowered to sign and execute the Agreement with the aforementioned groups.
